

NONPROFIT LEADERS LEARNING GROUP

A Program of the Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego

- WHAT The Nonprofit Leaders Learning Group is for senior managers and leadership team members, including those whose next career step, if desired, may be as CEO of a nonprofit organization. The group will meet for six one-day seminars held over a six-month period. *If in-person gatherings are not permitted by local health guidelines, the group will meet for twelve three-hour virtual sessions held in two consecutive weeks per month for six months.*
- WHY This is an opportunity for you to learn leadership concepts and styles, develop a network of resources for future use, and to establish new relationships with a supportive peer group. The group enables you to share with your peers in a confidential environment.
- WHEN If in-person gatherings are permitted, the seminars will be held from 9:00am to 4:00pm on the **second Wednesday** of the month for six months beginning *January 13, 2021*. *Virtual sessions will take place from 9:00am to 12:00pm on the first and second Wednesday each month for six months beginning January 6, 2021*.
- WHERE The group will meet at the offices of the Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego / Clare Rose Foundation located at 5060 Shoreham Place, Suite 350, San Diego, CA 92122. Should the group be unable to meet in person at any point due to public health guidelines, virtual learning group sessions will take place using Zoom.
- WHO The Learning Group is limited to 10 senior managers of nonprofits, selected to give a balance of size and experience. Each participant commits to participate in all six sessions.

The group's facilitator is Tom Hall, a nationally recognized nonprofit arts executive, theatre producer, consultant, and nonprofit management leader. As a consultant, nonprofit arts administrator, teacher, and commercial producer, he has actively worked to support growth in the nonprofit and commercial theatre and arts community at the local, state, and national level. Tom has participated in all aspects of the Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego since its inception and is committed to developing nonprofit mission-focused leadership as one of the best ways to create highly effective organizations.

HOW

Each fast-moving session will be broken down into five sections:

- An opportunity for members to present a current organization/leadership problem, which the group will then clarify and work together on to develop solutions.
- Feedback from members who have already presented and a discussion on the usefulness of solutions worked out at the previous meeting.
- A resource-sharing time.
- A presentation and discussion by the facilitator on a particular management model or topic requested by the group.
- A group evaluation of the effectiveness of the day and how the group can improve its own usefulness to one another.
- COST A nominal cost of \$600 per person is required. All other costs associated with the program are underwritten by Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego.

To participate in the Nonprofit Leaders Learning Group, you must agree with the following:

1. The Fieldstone Leadership Network SD Learning Group is one of peer learning that requires participation from the entire group, therefore, it is mandatory that you attend all sessions, whether in-person or virtual. The in-person sessions are one full day, from 9:00am to 4:00pm on the second Wednesday of the month. The virtual sessions will take place from 9:00am to 12:00pm, with an optional after-hours discussion time until 12:30pm. These sessions will take place on the 1st and 2nd Wednesdays of the month, according to the schedule below. If you are unable to complete any of the sessions, you may not be able to graduate from the Learning Group and your tuition will be forfeited.

- 2. If public health guidelines change during the six-month course, the group may switch from in-person sessions to virtual sessions or vice versa. A switch to in-person sessions from virtual sessions will be made in consultation with the group members.
- 3. If your employment status changes while in this program, you may continue in the program as long as you have attended the first session and intend to remain in the nonprofit sector.
- 4. The work of Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego includes the taking of pictures of our leadership programs and participants and involvement with the community. As a partner with us and participant in our various programs, you acknowledge that your image may appear in our photographs and videos. You agree to give permission to Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego and Clare Rose Foundation to use these images in our publications and communication vehicles, including our website and social media platforms.
