

ALL WE CAN SAVE: A LEARNING CIRCLE

WHAT

All We Can Save: A Learning Circle is a nine-month small-group experience focused on our climate crisis and environmental justice through the study of the book, *All We Can Save: Truth, Courage, and Solutions for the Climate Crisis*. The **Learning Circle** is presented as part of the Leadership Reading Group Program and Project Stone Catcher.

WHY

The **Learning Circle** will provide nonprofit leaders with resources, space, and generous dialogue about the climate crisis to connect and find their place in the “we” that is necessary to create a “just and livable future.” This program is offered to answer the call by *All We Can Save* for more leadership and participation in responding to our climate crisis and environmental injustice

WHEN

The Learning Circle will start on October 11, 2022 and will meet monthly through June of 2023 on the second Tuesday of each month from 9:00am to 11:00am. The dates for the nine-month program are: October 11, 2022, November 8, 2022, December 13, 2022, January 10, 2023, February 14, 2023, March 14, 2023, April 11, 2023, May 9, 2023, and June 13, 2023.

WHERE

All meetings will take place at the Fieldstone Leadership Network SD offices at 5060 Shoreham Place, Suite 350, San Diego, CA 92122. *Should the group be unable to meet in person at any point due to public health guidelines, the program will switch to virtual sessions using Zoom.*

WHO

The Learning Circle is a peer-learning experience that will be limited to 12 nonprofit leaders. As a peer-learning experience, it requires the presence and participation of each member each month to be impactful for all. Please plan on blocking off all the Circle meeting dates on your calendar now if you are applying for this program.

The Learning Circle curriculum was designed by Dr. Katharine Wilkinson, one of the book’s editors to follow the flow of the book. The group’s facilitator will be Mary Jo Schumann, PhD, a graduate of our Leadership Reading Group program.

HOW

Applications for **The Learning Circle** are due by August 16, 2022. The book, *All We Can Save*, will be mailed to participants at the end of August.

Participants will be asked to read the book’s prologue “Begin” and the first chapter, “Root” prior to the first meeting in October. Following the flow of the book, the participants will read a new chapter each month moving next to “Advocate” and then on to “Reframe,” “Reshape,” “Persist,” “Feel,” “Nourish,” “Rise,” and ending with “Onward.” *All We Can Save* is an anthology with collected writings from sixty women at the forefront of the climate movement. The chapters are approximately 30-40 pages each and include selections from multiple authors.
