

LEADERSHIP READING GROUP

A Program of the Fieldstone Leadership Network San Diego

WHAT

The **Leadership Reading Group** is a ten-month program that offers a unique opportunity to study and develop leadership in a communal setting. Participants will read and discuss a new book each month selected from a professionally curated list that includes fiction, non-fiction, and trade (business) books relevant to nonprofit leaders.

WHY

Research has shown that reading is an essential component of leadership development (HBR, Feb 2016). The **Leadership Reading Group** is designed to help leaders to commit to and develop a systematic reading habit while also building and deepening diverse professional relationships within the sector through shared learning. The **Reading Group** also provides the facilitation training necessary for participants to feel more comfortable and confident leading professional discussions.

WHEN

The Leadership Reading Group will start on September 4, 2025 and will meet monthly through June of 2026 on first Thursday of each month from 11:30am to 1:30pm, with three exceptions to avoid holidays noted below. The dates for the ten-month program are: September 4, 2025, October 9, 2025*, November 6, 2025, December 4, 2025, January 8, 2026*, February 5, 2026, March 5, 2026, April 9, 2026*, May 7, 2026, and June 4, 2026.

*October meeting is on the second week of the month on Thursday, January meeting is on the second week of the month on Thursday, and April meeting is on the second week of the month Thursday.

WHERE

All meetings will take place at the Fieldstone Leadership Network SD offices at 5060 Shoreham Place, Suite 350, San Diego, CA 92122. Should the group be unable to meet in person at any point due to public health guidelines, the program will switch to virtual sessions using Zoom.

WHO

The **Leadership Reading Group** is a peer-learning experience for 12 nonprofit leaders. It is open to nonprofit executives and senior managers in the San Diego area. As a peer-learning experience, it requires the presence and participation of each member each month to be impactful for all. Please plan on blocking off all the meeting dates now if you are applying for this program.

The **Reading Group** is facilitated by Stefanie Schiff, a literary consultant and founder of San Diego Book Talk with 20 years of experience leading professional reading groups.

HOW

Applications for **the Leadership Reading Group** are due by July 15, 2025. Selection decisions will be announced by August 15, 2025.

The first meeting on September 4, 2025 will be an introductory meeting where participants will spend time getting to know more about each other and the program. The reading list will be distributed at this meeting and the first book selection will be announced. The next three meetings will be facilitated by our professional facilitator. The following six meetings will be led by the participants working as two-person teams. Each pair will select a book to facilitate from our professionally curated reading list.

COST

We remain deeply committed to affordability. To keep our programs both accessible and sustainable, we have adopted a sliding scale fee structure based on organizational budget size. This approach allows us to equitably share program costs while continuing to offer high-quality experiences for all participants. Please see the chart on page 2 of the application to identify the cost for your organization. Checks can be made payable to the CLARE ROSE FOUNDATION and includes facilitation, training, and lunch. Books are not included in the program fee and are the responsibility of the participants.
