Renew: A REtreat Series for Nonprofit Leaders

Recenter. Reconnect. Reimagine. Restore.

Series Overview

Nonprofit leaders carry extraordinary responsibilities, holding vision, navigating challenges, and supporting others while often setting aside their own well-being. **Renew: A REtreat Series for Nonprofit Leaders** offers four daylong experiences designed to nurture resilience and renewal.

These unique gatherings offer time to reflect, gain perspective, and make connections. Art, nature, movement, and other activities are held in creative settings to give leaders a respite from the demands of the workplace and return with a sense of renewal.

The series kicks off in May 2026 with sessions a Friday of the each month, May through August. The gatherings will take place 9:30 am - 3:30 pm. Each gathering will be hosted at an inspirational nonprofit location and include up to 24 leaders to help cultivate connections between participants.

Each retreat focuses on a distinct dimension of renewal, while the series as a whole offers a developmental arc: from **grounding**, to **connection**, to **possibility**, to **sustainability**. Leaders may attend individual retreats or participate in the full series.

Format

- **Time:** 9:30 AM – 3:30 PM
- **Location:** Varies; creative and restorative spaces in nature and the arts
- **Who:** Nonprofit professionals and retirees working in San Diego County, no previous Fieldstone experience necessary.
- **Group Size:** Up to 24 nonprofit leaders per retreat
- **Lunch Included**, as well as coffee, tea and cold drinks throughout the day
- **Cost:** Individual retreats are \$225

REconnect

May 15, 2026

Location: Coastal Roots Farm, Encinitas

Theme: Returning to balance and grounding

- **Focus:** Leaders pause, breathe, and reconnect with their inner compass and vocation.
- **Practices:** Mindfulness, journaling, embodied movement, time in nature.
- **Outcome:** Participants leave with clarity and renewed alignment with their values.

REcenter

Date: June 12, 2026

Location: Olivewood Gardens and Learning Center, National City

Theme: Deepening relationships and community

- **Focus:** Leaders strengthen ties with peers, collaborators, and their sense of belonging.
- **Practices:** Story circles, dialogue, collaborative art, shared meals.
- **Outcome:** Participants gain perspective, feel less isolated, and build authentic connections.

REimagine

Date: July 10, 2026

Location: Liberty Station, Point Loma

Theme: Opening to creativity and new possibilities

- **Focus:** Leaders explore fresh perspectives for themselves and their organizations.
- **Practices:** Visioning exercises, creativity labs (art, design thinking), playful exploration.
- **Outcome:** Participants feel inspired and see new opportunities for impact and joy in their work.

REstore

Date: August 14, 2026

Location: Camp Stevens, Julian

Theme: Integrating wisdom and sustaining the journey

- **Focus:** Leaders weave together insights from the series and replenish their energy for the work.
- **Practices:** Reflection rituals, gratitude practices, symbolic closing ceremony.
- **Outcome:** Participants leave feeling restored, sustained, and supported for the long term.

Recenter → Ground yourself. **Reconnect** → Strengthen relationships.

Reimagine → Open to possibility. **Restore** → Return balanced and renewed.
